

## **WONDERFUL WATERS**

 $\mathcal{V}$ ilas County lakes have been luring people to the Northwoods for more than a century. These waterways are still as beautiful and unspoiled as they were during the days of the steam trains.

If you're looking for a paddling adventure, you've found the perfect place. Launch your canoe, kayak or stand-up paddleboard on one of our established routes or chart your own course. You'll find hidden ponds and quiet waters as well as routes that can take days to explore.

Outfitters on the Wisconsin River help visitors enjoy a day tubing along wild shores—tubers frequently spot bald eagles.

On warm summer days, there's nothing more refreshing than a swim in a Northwoods lake. Dive into the cool, clear waters of a Vilas County lake or soak up the sun in the soft sand of a secluded, postcard-perfect beach. There are plenty of public beaches, and many of our resorts and lodging properties have beaches for their guests.

Throughout the year, Vilas County's rich fishing waters attract anglers. Here, you'll find everything from crappie, yellow perch and bluegill to hard-fighting walleye, pike and musky. Vilas County lakes also hold some of the biggest, most beautiful smallmouth bass in the state. When temperatures drop, grab your auger to experience some of the best ice fishing in the Northwoods.

Boaters will find endless waters to explore, including expansive lakes ideal for a day cruise and lakes that are ideal for waterskiing and tubing.

## FAGIF RIVFR CHAIN

 ${\mathcal O}$ ne of the most well-known chains in the Northwoods is the 1 Eagle River Chain of Lakes. In fact, it's the largest freshwater chain of lakes in the world. It connects with the Three Lakes Chain to the south, so boaters have a total of 28 lakes and 174 miles of shoreline to explore. The Eagle River portion of the chain includes ten lakes covering 3,600 acres, including small waters like 31-acre Lynx Lake and expansive lakes like the nearly 1,000-acre Catfish Lake.

## CISCO CHAIN

 ${\mathcal G}$ n far northern Vilas County, the Cisco Chain takes boaters into Michigan waters. With 15 lakes and 270 miles of shoreline, it's a chain of substantial size. Big Lake, West Bay and Mamie Lake extend into Vilas County and connect with lakes like Cisco and Thousand Island Lakes to the north.

## LAC DIL FLAMBFALL CHAIN

 ${\mathcal T}$ his spring-fed 10-lake chain is known for its abundant fish and clear water. It's anchored by Fence Lake, a clear, 3.483acre lake containing musky, panfish, smallmouth bass, northern pike and walleye. There are many places to get on the water, and one of the chain's lakes, Long Interlaken, borders downtown Lac du Flambeau.

## MANITOWISH WATERS CHAIN

 $\mathcal G$ n Manitowish Waters, you'll find a  $oldsymbol{6}$  10-lake chain with some great fishing and an interesting history. The chain includes Rest Lake, Stone Lake, Fawn Lake, Clear Lake, Little Star Lake, Island Lake, Alder Lake, Spider Lake, Wild Rice Lake and Manitowish Lake. The lake that helped the chain gain fame is Little Star Lake, home to Little Bohemia Lodge, site of a 1934 shootout between John Dillinger and the FBI.

 $\mathcal{W}$ ith 1,300 lakes and 73 rivers and streams, Vilas County has nearly limitless places to cast a line. We have big lakes with plenty of open water and small lakes that are rarely fished. Want to make the most of your Vilas County fishing trip? Here are some answers to a few common questions.

WHERE SHOULD I FISH? You can barely drive a country mile in Vilas County without passing a decent fishing lake. Our lake grid (pages 11-14) details waters with public access that will help you find beautiful fishing waters like North Twin Lake in Phelps. The grid includes species of fish, the size and depth of each lake and boat launch details, along with GPS coordinates. Punch the coordinates into an Internet browser or the mobile map of your choosing and you'll see the lake on a map.

WHAT FISHING EVENTS ARE COMING UP? We have tournaments for competitive anglers, seminars for those who want to learn more and special events for kids. See them on page 34.

DO I NEED A BOAT? No! There are endless places to enjoy shore fishing. You'll find accessible piers or good shore fishing at Upper Gresham Lake in Boulder Junction, Rest Lake in Manitowish Waters, Star Lake in Sayner-Star Lake and several locations in Presque Isle, including Horsehead Lake, Little Horsehead Lake and Oxbow Lake.

How can I be sure to Land a big Fish? There are no guarantees in life, but we'll guarantee that your chances of success will improve drastically if you hire a fishing guide. Guides can share lessons you'll use for a lifetime. Plus, they're a bargain when you factor in the great value of being able to use their boat and equipment.

 $\mathcal{V}$ ilas County's lakes have produced some big fish, and the biggest have broken state records. There was the 54-inch tiger musky caught on 4 Lac Vieux Desert in 1919, and the 29-inch silver redhorse caught in Plum Creek in 1985. There was the 18-pound walleye landed on High Lake in 1933 and the 4.3-inch mottled sculpin (they are small!) captured in Gunlock Lake last year. Records are meant to be broken, and they just might be broken here again. Cast a line and try your luck.

## ADVENTURE: SPRING & SUMMER

Warm weather and longer days bring fresh opportunities for adventure in Vilas County and some of the best vacation moments happen on the water. For hundreds of years people have been paddling the lakes and rivers of Vilas County. Chart your own course—the Wisconsin River alone offers nearly 50 miles of paddling from the headwaters in Land O' Lakes south to Conover and Eagle River and west to St. Germain.

Vilas County is also home to vast forests that beckon nature lovers. A beautiful place for a hike is the Star Lake Nature Trail, which will take you onto a scenic peninsula. Hikers interested in a longer adventure can explore the 1.5 million-acre 

Nicolet National Forest via the Anvil Lake Trail, just east of Eagle River. The trail is just off Old Military Road, an 1800s route that follows a Native American trail used for hundreds of years (part of the Nicolet-Wolf River Scenic Byway). The longest trail in the county is the Heart of Vilas County Paved Bike Trail System. Ride 52 miles of paved trail connecting Boulder Junction, Sayner-Star Lake, Manitowish Waters, St. Germain and Mercer.


In northern Vilas County, bikers can explore a beautiful road route that connects Winchester and Presque Isle. Mountain bikers will find scenery on the Raven Trail in Woodruff and a few thrills on the expansive WinMan Trails between Winchester and Manitowish Waters. Near Conover is the Vilas County Equestrian Trail System—it's connected to the River Road Equestrian Campground via the Torch Lake Equestrian Loop.

ATV riders can also explore Vilas County's expanding riding options. Discover routes connecting the communities of Eagle River, Conover, Phelps, Land O' Lakes, St. Germain and Arbor Vitae. A scenic paved and dirt road/trail route will take you through the forest from Arbor Vitae to St. Germain, skirting Big St. Germain Lake. Adventurer/dual-sport motorcycle riders will find endless routes to explore, including miles of unpaved county forest roads.

Back on land, explore native history on the reservation of the Lac du Flambeau Band of Lake Superior Chippewa. Weekly pow wows take place through the summer on Tuesdays, and the ③ George W. Brown, Jr. Ojibwe Museum & Cultural Center features exhibits like a world-record sturgeon and a 24-foot dugout canoe.

Looking for family fun? Check out the wildlife in a Northwoods zoo or head to a go-kart track and see who is the fastest!

All of these activities might make you hungry. Good spots to pull over include Manitowish Waters, where you'll find great coffee, and Land O' Lakes, where you can ride up to an ice cream stand. Throughout the county you'll find friendly taverns for lunch and restaurants with sunset views. Whether you're looking for a classic cocktail or unforgettable dessert, you'll find it in Vilas County.



## ADVENTURE: FALL

Every autumn, the show returns. As the air cools, the ferns begin to turn a beautiful golden brown and then trees burst into color—ash and birch trees take on beautiful shades of gold; maple trees light up in hues of orange and red. Vilas County has more than 240,000 acres of public land, and it's one of the best places in Wisconsin for taking in fall colors.

If you're looking for an unforgettable hike, there's no better time to get on the trails. If you're seeking relaxation, there's nothing like warming near the first fire of the season. If you feel like shopping, this is the perfect time to explore quaint stores across Vilas County.

Vilas County has nine spectacular golf courses, including the challenging ② Eagle River Golf Course and the ⑧ Plum Lake Golf Club, which first opened in 1912.

A great place for a fall paddle is NHAL Canoe Trip #3, a route from Boulder Junction to Manitowish Waters— it includes several lakes and some wild river stretches. While in Manitowish Waters get an up-close look at some cranberry farms—along with Eagle River, this area helps Wisconsin lead the nation in cranberry production. Tours of cranberry farms are available from July to early October.

Afterwards, take a fall cruise on the ① Eagle River Chain of Lakes. This 9-lake chain covers nearly 3,600 acres, and, when combined with the adjoining Three Lakes Chain, is the largest chain of freshwater lakes in the world! Learn more about exploring Vilas County's Lake chains on page 25.

Fall colors provide a beautiful backdrop for fishing. Catch a view and perhaps a trophy on Big St. Germain Lake, a 1,600-acre lake that's highly rated by local anglers.

Take in miles of scenery by car or bike. West of Star Lake, the twisting Rustic Road #60 provides a dramatic fall drive. In the southeast corner of the county, you can explore the scenic roads of the Nicolet-Wolf River Scenic Byway. A pleasant fall road biking route: County Highway S in Land O' Lakes and Conover. Or, ride the Vista Lake Bike Route in Phelps—the route includes three beautiful loops in the Nicolet National Forest.

Keep an eye on the sky. Migratory birds wing their way through Vilas County every fall. A good birding spot is the Powell Marsh Trail, an area between Manitowish Waters and Lac du Flambeau.


Caramel apple lovers: celebrate autumn at a fall festival. There are community celebrations taking place virtually every weekend in the fall. These events are filled with beautiful crafts, delicious food and lively music.

## **ADVENTURE: WINTER**

 $\mathcal{G}_n$  Vilas County, we measure winter fun by the foot. Every year, we're blanketed with a heavy layer of snow that creates fresh opportunities for adventure and relaxation. Located in the Lake Superior snowbelt, we receive a ton of snow—on average, more than six feet each winter! That means Vilas County is heaven for people who love the outdoors. Our more than 1,300 lakes offer endless possibilities for ice fishermen, and the county's vast snow-frosted forests provide a stunning backdrop to winter getaways.

Start your big adventure with a hearty breakfast in one of Vilas County's many restaurants. They open early and offer all the classics—hot coffee, pancakes, bacon and eggs, just how you like them.

Next, head out for some snowshoeing. Just south of Boulder Junction, the Lumberjack Trail offers great scenery not far from rental spots. Near Presque Isle, an outing at the Van Vliet Hemlocks will take you past 400-year-old trees. Vilas County is laced with miles of well-maintained cross-country ski trails.

The Pioneer Creek Trails in Conover have miles of trails for snowshoeing and cross-country skiing and offer a warming shelter with heated restrooms. South of Winchester, the WinMan Trails offers expansive ski and groomed fat bike trails in a 1,300-acre natural area.

If you're looking for more frozen adventures, you won't have to look far—just find some ice. Fishermen flock to Vilas County for quiet spots like Boulder Lake in Boulder Junction. Another great spot: Stormy Lake near Conover, a spot that is far more tranquil than its name suggests. Vilas County is also home to nearly a dozen ice fishing tournaments, including events for new anglers like the free Annual Kids' Fishing Jamboree in Land O' Lakes.



# SWINGING OVER SQUAW LAKE WAITING FOR SPRING

Fishing isn't the only way to win on the ice—every February, Eagle River hosts the Pond Hockey National Championships. Teams come from all over the country, in many case reuniting teammates who first hit the ice together decades ago.

Noncompetitive skaters: take the kids to one of Vilas County's many outdoor rinks like Conover Town Park, which has a heated restroom, or the Snowflake Ice Rink in Land O' Lakes with lights for night skating and a warming house.

Sled heads can explore over 700 miles of snowmobile trails—you can get virtually anywhere via this trail network. In Phelps, you can pick up a trail within a block of town and launch an adventure that continues across the county and beyond. Visit trails.vilas.org to download the updated Map It Vilas County trails app, to help you navigate the county's snowmobile routes as well as skiing and snowshoeing trails.

Ride to Sayner-Star Lake to pay homage to the birthplace of the snowmobile—you'll be touring some of the oldest snowmobile trails in the state. Another sledding shrine: Eagle River, known around the world as a snowmobiler's mecca. It hosts both the annual Vintage Derby and World Championship Snowmobile Derby at the World Championship Derby Complex, drawing more than 1,400 riders and crowds of 30,000 every January.

The derby is just one of our lively winter racing events. In February, you'll see other fast snowmobiles competing in the St. Germain Radar Run and some fast paws competing for cold cash at the Three Bear Sled Dog Races, held in Land O' Lakes.

The Winter Park Bark Skijor Race, held in March in Minocqua, is a unique style of racing involving cross-country skiing while attached to an energetic dog. The dogs and the skiers put on a show!



 $\mathcal{W}$  hat's the most popular activity in Vilas County? According to visitors we speak with, it can be summed up in one word: relaxation.





## GET THE MAP IT VILAS COUNTY TRAILS APP

The free Map It Vilas County trails app is your key to discovering Vilas County's trails. Here's a quick guide to the app.

- 1. **BEFORE YOU GO:** Download the Map It Vilas County trails app at trails.vilas.org. The app is free and versions are available for Apple and Android devices.
- 2. START DREAMING. The perfect trail is out there: use the app to find it. The app will show you all the public trails; the filters will help you zero in on one to explore. Select as many or as few options as you like; selecting more options will help you find just the right trail. For example, you can find hiking trails in Presque Isle that allow dogs, bike trails in Boulder Junction that are equipped with free repair stations and the snowmobile trails in Eagle River.
- 3. MAKE IT HAPPEN! Use the app's "Trail Information" section to find a trailhead and parking and see a helpful description of the trail. Once you're on the trail, use the "Interactive Map" section to stay on the right path. A dot on the map will indicate your position—if you're wondering how far you are from your car or campsite or if there's a lake around the bend, just look at the app! The app will even display a trail map when there's no cell service available.
- 4. ENJOY. While the app is rich with trail details, the biggest benefit is what you'll find off your device—an unforgettable wilderness experience. You'll be able to navigate the backcountry like a local and find the beautiful hidden spots that make Vilas County trails so special.





 $\mathcal V$ ilas County has miles of marked ATV/UTV routes, including some easy-riding routes and trails in Conover, Phelps, Land O' Lakes, St. Germain, Eagle River and Arbor Vitae. These routes, usually open from early May to the end of October, connect to other area trails and routes to the east and west. The routes and trails are all clearly marked, so you'll have no trouble getting around.
