Lac du Flambeau

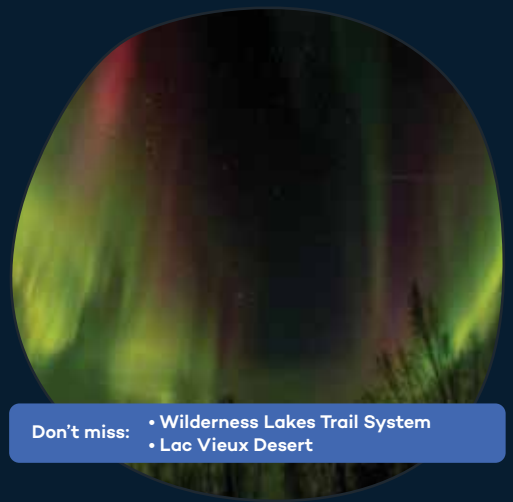

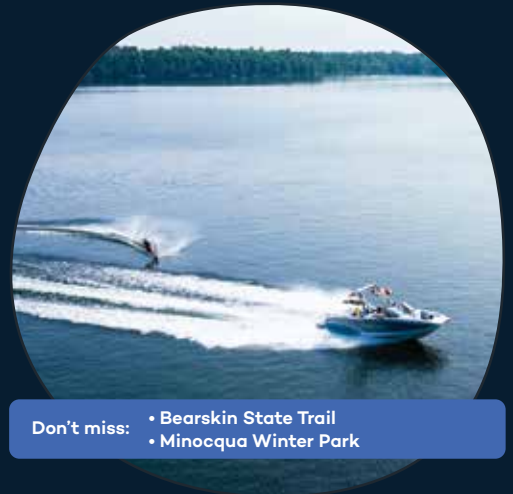

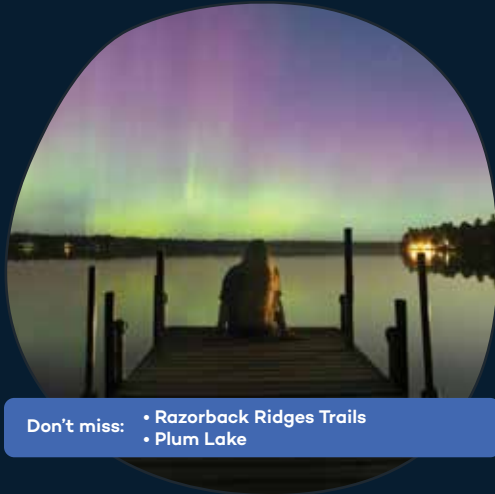
Presque Isle

Lakes & Rivers

Anglers will find some of the best fishing in the Midwest, and swimmers and watersports enthusiasts will find welcoming lakes and can't-miss beaches.

Best bets for boating, canoeing & kayaking



Boating:

The Eagle River Chain of Lakes and Lac Vieux Desert

One of the Northwoods' most well-known lake chains, the Eagle River Chain of Lakes is the largest freshwater chain of lakes in the world, encompassing 29 lakes between the Eagle River chain and the Three Lakes Chain to the south. The Eagle River chain offers a wide variety of boating options, from 1,000-acre Catfish Lake to 22-acre Lynx Lake. Boaters can access the lakes from many public boat launches, including sites on Catfish Lake, Cranberry Lake, Eagle Lake, Lynx Lake, and others.

Lac Vieux Desert near Land O' Lakes is where the Wisconsin River gets its start (you can see the headwaters at Lac Vieux Desert Reservoir Park on the southwest side of the lake), but it's also a great lake for boating, offering a stunning 4,000 acres to explore. The lake straddles the border of Wisconsin and Michigan's Upper Peninsula and is home to several lakeside resorts and campgrounds.

Kayaking:

Allequash Lake and Island Lake

Allequash Lake, located south of Boulder Junction, is part of the Allequash Lake and Pines State Natural Area in the Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest. The 400-acre lake is divided into large basins, and the southern basin has a no-motor restriction, so it's perfect for kayaking. Follow Allequash Lake Road east from Highway M to reach the boat landing.



Island Lake is an 865-acre body of water near Manitowish Waters in western Vilas County. It's also located within the Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest, and it's designated as a wild lake, meaning motorized watercraft are not allowed.

Canoeing:

The Wisconsin River and the Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest

Want to get out on the water on one of the state's most scenic and iconic rivers? The Wisconsin River starts in Vilas County and flows throughout the Northwoods, offering lots of great opportunities for paddlers. Up for a longer paddle? Try one of the Wisconsin River Centennial Trips.

The Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest is filled with lakes and waterways—it's got more than 900 lakes and over 300 miles of rivers and streams.

Many lakes have "no motor" or "electric motor only" designations, so you don't have to worry about speedboats zipping by, allowing you to enjoy the undeveloped splendor of the Northwoods. The NHAL is also home to more than 70 canoe campsites and six suggested overnight paddling trips.

Keep Vilas County's lakes & waterways clean

Through the Clean Boats, Clean Waters watercraft inspection program, volunteers perform boat and trailer checks at lakes across Wisconsin and educate boaters and anglers on how and where invasive species are most likely to appear.

So, what can you do to make sure you're not helping aquatic hitchhikers? Wisconsin has various laws in place for boaters and anglers to help prevent the introduction and spread of invasive species.

All boaters are required to:

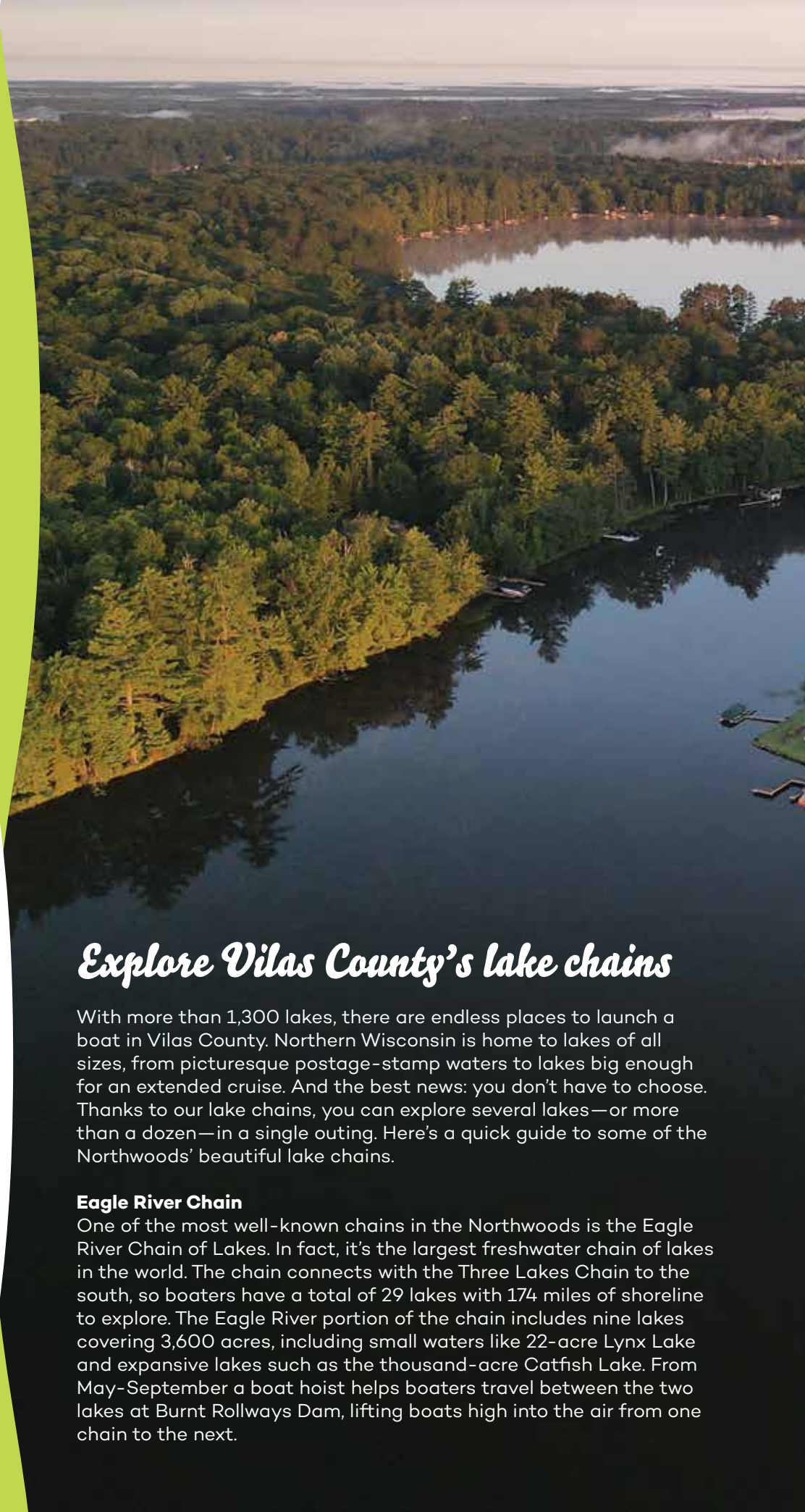
- Inspect boat, trailers, and equipment
- Remove all attached aquatic plants and animals before launching, after loading, and before transporting watercraft on a public highway
- Drain all water from boats, motors, and equipment
- Never move plants or live fish away from a body of water
- Dispose of unwanted bait in the trash
- Buy minnows from a Wisconsin bait dealer; leftover minnows can only be used under certain conditions
- Violations of these laws can lead to fines

Explore Vilas County's lake chains

With more than 1,300 lakes, there are endless places to launch a boat in Vilas County. Northern Wisconsin is home to lakes of all sizes, from picturesque postage-stamp waters to lakes big enough for an extended cruise. And the best news: you don't have to choose. Thanks to our lake chains, you can explore several lakes—or more than a dozen—in a single outing. Here's a quick guide to some of the Northwoods' beautiful lake chains.

Eagle River Chain

One of the most well-known chains in the Northwoods is the Eagle River Chain of Lakes. In fact, it's the largest freshwater chain of lakes in the world. The chain connects with the Three Lakes Chain to the south, so boaters have a total of 29 lakes with 174 miles of shoreline to explore. The Eagle River portion of the chain includes nine lakes covering 3,600 acres, including small waters like 22-acre Lynx Lake and expansive lakes such as the thousand-acre Catfish Lake. From May-September a boat hoist helps boaters travel between the two lakes at Burnt Rollways Dam, lifting boats high into the air from one chain to the next.





Cisco Chain

In far northern Vilas County, the Cisco Chain takes boaters into Michigan waters. With 15 lakes and 270 miles of shoreline, it's one of the biggest chains in the world. Big Lake, West Bay, and Mamie Lake extend into Vilas County and connect with lakes like Cisco and Thousand Island Lakes to the north.

Lac du Flambeau Chain

This spring-fed 10-lake chain is known for its abundant fish and clear water. It's anchored by Fence Lake, a clear, 3,483-acre lake that contains musky, panfish, smallmouth bass, northern pike, and walleye. There are many places to get on the water and one of the chain's lakes, Long Interlaken, borders downtown Lac du Flambeau.

Manitowish Waters Chain

In Manitowish Waters, you'll find a 10-lake chain with some great fishing and an interesting history. The chain includes Rest Lake, Stone Lake, Fawn Lake, Clear Lake, Island Lake, Alder Lake, Spider Lake, Wild Rice Lake, and Manitowish Lake. The lake that helped the chain gain fame is Little Star Lake, home to Little Bohemia Lodge, site of a 1934 gangster shootout involving John Dillinger.

Minocqua Chain

Just south of Arbor Vitae, this chain will take you through Oneida County. It includes 700-acre Kawaguesaga Lake, Lake Minocqua, Mid Lake, and Lake Tomahawk. These lakes are close to Vilas County lodging and dining, so they offer boaters another nearby chain option to explore.

Four great fishing lakes in Vilas County

The Northwoods of Wisconsin is home to one of the highest concentrations of freshwater lakes on the planet, so there's always somewhere to cast a line, whether you're going after hard-fighting bass or elusive musky.

Trout Lake

Size: 3,864 acres

Most abundant fish: Musky, panfish, smallmouth bass, northern pike, trout

Located south of Boulder Junction, this massive lake is home to a rich fishery with healthy populations of musky, bass, pike, walleye, and trout (which aren't easy to find in a lot of Northwoods lakes). Public boat landings are located at Ben Bendrick Drive and at campgrounds along County Highway M.

Big St. Germain Lake

Size: 1,622 acres

Most abundant fish: Musky, panfish, northern pike, walleye

Located just west of St. Germain and north of State Highway 70, Big St. Germain Lake is a popular destination for musky and walleye, but pike and panfish are also prolific. Public access is via a boat launch on the north side of the lake. Note that there's also a Little St. Germain Lake (972 acres) slightly to the east.

Clear Lake

Size: 515 acres

Most abundant fish: Musky, panfish, northern pike, walleye

Anglers enjoy the fishing opportunities for musky, pike, and walleye on this lake just east of Manitowish Waters on the western side of Vilas County. True to its name (and because it's spring-fed), the water is remarkably clear. Public boat landings can be found at Haskins Road and off Clear Lake Road.

Lac Vieux Desert

Size: 4,017 acres

Most abundant fish: Musky, panfish, largemouth bass, smallmouth bass, northern pike, walleye

Straddling the border of Wisconsin and Michigan's Upper Peninsula east of Land O' Lakes, this large lake is the headwaters for the mighty Wisconsin River and also offers good fishing opportunities for panfish, bass, and walleye. A boat ramp can be found on the southeastern side of the lake near Thunder Bay Resort and carry-in access is available at Lac Vieux Desert Park on the southwest side of the lake.

Native to some Northwoods lakes
Common catch size: 27 inches



Largemouth Bass

Hides under lily pads, docks, and in weed beds
Common catch size: 12-14 inches



Muskellunge

Largest predatory fish in the state
Common catch size: 24-30 inches



Northern Pike

When hungry, will attack almost any bait
Common catch size: 18-24 inches



Perch

Found in most Wisconsin lakes
Common catch size: 7-10 inches



Pumpkinseed

Member of the sunfish family
Common catch size: 4-5 inches



Smallmouth Bass

Scrappy game fish, generally smaller than largemouth
Common catch size: 12 inches



Walleye

Member of the perch family
Common catch size: 14-17 inches



White Crappie

Tend to be slightly larger than black crappie
Common catch size: 7-10 inches

Summer

Summer is the perfect time to enjoy Vilas County, and visitors from across the Midwest and the country have been doing just that for more than a century. Whether you're cruising on a pontoon boat on one of Vilas County's scenic lakes, enjoying the trails by bike or by foot, or just dipping your toes in the sand at a local beach, you'll discover the bounty of outdoor options the Northwoods offers every visitor in the summer.

Trails you shouldn't miss in Vilas County

Don't miss the show this summer in the Northwoods of Wisconsin. Vilas County's forests offer some truly stunning scenery, and there are more than 75 multi-use trails to explore across the county, whether you want a short stroll or a longer, more challenging trip.

Discover family-friendly options

For a hike that's great for nature lovers of all ages, check out the **Presque Isle Nature Trail** (located behind the Presque Isle Community Center), which has a wheelchair-accessible stretch, and the **Spectacle Lake-Kentuck Lake Trail** in Phelps, which follows a smooth former railroad bed on an out-and-back trail between the Spectacle Lake and Kentuck Lake campgrounds.

All about the Heart of Vilas County Trail

- Designated as a National Recreational Trail, an award given to trails of special significance
- Runs for more than 52 miles through St. Germain, Sayner-Star Lake, Boulder Junction, and Manitowish Waters in Vilas County and Mercer in Iron County
- 20 parking areas located along the trail
- No fee or trail pass required
- Trail also features repair stations, restrooms, rest areas & swimming beaches
- Info on trail segments can be found on the Map It Vilas County trails app

Try these longer routes

Feel like covering some ground? Vilas County has plenty of trails with loops that will take anywhere from an hour to an afternoon to complete. A couple nice trails that offer longer hiking options include the **Fallison Lake Trail** near Boulder Junction (its longest loop is approximately 2.5 miles) and the **Catherine Wolter Wilderness Area** in Presque Isle (two loops of approximately 3 miles each, as well as several secondary and unmaintained trails).

Challenging hikes for trail lovers

Vilas County also has hiking options for those who want longer, hillier hikes. The **WinMan Trails** between Winchester and Manitowish Waters offer lots of loops to explore on 1,300 acres of private and public land. Conover's **Langlely Lake Trails** offer a combined 15 miles of routes and nicely varied terrain throughout the Vilas County Forest.

Fall

How to take in fall color in Vilas County

Looking for the best way to enjoy the fall color show in Vilas County? Here are a few ideas.

Hiking trails

If you want to take a scenic stroll through the Northwoods, you're in luck: Vilas County is home to hundreds of miles of walking and hiking trails, from gentle lakeside paths to more challenging routes that cut through the woods and forests of Vilas County.

Here are a few trails to try:

- Lumberjack Trail (Boulder Junction)
- Torch Lake Trails (Conover)
- Anvil Lake Trail (Eagle River)
- Powell Trail (Lac du Flambeau)
- Guido Rahr Sr. Tenderfoot Forest Preserve Trail (Land O' Lakes)
- North Lakeland Discovery Center Trails (Manitowish Waters)

On the water

Northern Wisconsin is home to one of the largest concentrations of freshwater lakes on the planet, so it's easy to get out on the water, whether you're paddling, boating, or fishing. The county also boasts some impressive lake chains, including the Eagle River Chain and the Cisco Chain.

Fishing and boating lakes to explore:

- Kawaguesaga Lake (Minocqua)
- Big Sand Lake (Phelps)
- Oxbow Lake (Presque Isle)
- Plum Lake (Sayner-Star Lake)
- Big St. Germain Lake (St. Germain)

A fantastic fall ride:

Rustic Road 60

Take in the sights and sounds of fall on Vilas County's only designated Rustic Road. Rustic Road 60 is a winding 12-mile route that will take you through the heart of the Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest. The route runs from County Highway K south of Boulder Junction to County Highway N in Sayner-Star Lake. Rustic Road 60 passes old logging camps, hiking trails and a former sawmill.

Along the way, you'll pass Lost Canoe Lake. You probably won't see the missing canoe, but you will pass some unique rails that people use to launch boats from the highway. The lake is a popular fishing spot for walleye, largemouth bass, and northern pike.

On the east side of the road, you'll pass the turnoff for the Star Lake Nature Trail (Statehouse Road). This is a nice scenic spot to stretch your legs; you can follow a nature trail with boardwalks that will take you out into a peninsula on Star Lake—a great place to take in the view.

Info on trail segments can be found on the Map It Vilas County trails app.

ATVing & UTVing in Vilas County

Here's what you need to know before you launch your ATVing and UTVing adventure in Vilas County:

- Vilas County's ATV/UTV route system connects St. Germain, Arbor Vitae, Lincoln, Eagle River, Conover, Phelps, Presque Isle, and Land O' Lakes
- You can find ATV/UTV routes on the free Map It Vilas County trails app or get paper maps from local ATV clubs
- Vilas County's ATV/UTV routes are open from early May through the end of October, depending on trail conditions
- Riders without their own ATV/UTV can rent vehicles from outfitters in Conover, Eagle River, Phelps, Land O' Lakes, and St. Germain
- ATV and UTV users born on or after January 1, 1988, who are at least 12 years old (for ATVers; the age requirement is 16 for UTVers) must complete a safety certification course in order to operate on public ATV/UTV trails in the state

Winter

A whole new season of fun opens up in Vilas County when the snow flies. Vilas County is where the snowmobile was born, and it's home to hundreds of miles of expertly groomed trails as well as popular attractions like Snowmobile Hall of Fame in St. Germain and the World Snowmobile Headquarters in Eagle River. Those interested in more leisurely pursuits can enjoy dozens of cross-country skiing and snowshoeing trails that wind through the scenic, snow-covered Northwoods.

Easy-to-explore winter trails

Here's a look at a few trails where you can take a relaxing hike, ski, or snowshoe through northern Wisconsin's beautiful winter scenery.

Van Vliet Hemlocks, Presque Isle

This state natural area south of Presque Isle spans more than 400 acres and is a great place for cross-country skiing and snowshoeing. (Note that cross-country ski trails are ungroomed.) Skiers and snowshoers can choose from trails that vary in distance from less than half a mile to a combined route that covers more than 3 miles. The trails at the Van Vliet Hemlocks State Natural Area offer beautiful Northwoods scenery, passing by Averill Lake, Van Vliet Lake, and Hemlock Lake, and the protected area is also home to one of the largest old-growth hemlock forests in Wisconsin.

Razorback Ridges, Sayner-Star Lake

This large trail system west of Sayner-Star Lake has more than 25 miles of groomed cross-country ski trails, snowshoe trails, as well as a warming building with bathroom facilities. (In summer, Razorback Ridges is open for mountain biking and hiking.) The cross-country ski and snowshoe trails cater to users of all skill levels, from beginner to advanced. The trails were created as a community project between the Sayner-Star Lake Lions Club in cooperation with the Wisconsin DNR, and the trails are maintained by members of the Lions Club. There is no trail fee, but donations are appreciated.

Escanaba-Palette Lake Trails, Boulder Junction

Located in the Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest, this trail system just south of Boulder Junction is a great place to visit if you're a cross-country skier looking for a little more of a challenge. The Escanaba-Palette Lake Trails offer loops of 2 to nearly 9 miles around Escanaba and Palette Lakes. There is a shelter and a fire ring on the north side of the trail system between the two lakes, and the trail connects to the Lumberjack Trail to the north. Note that since this is a state-owned property, a Wisconsin State Trail Pass (\$5 daily, \$25 annual) is required for skiers 16 and older; self-registration is available at the trailhead off Nebish Lake Road.

Snowmobile routes to try

Get ready to ride! Here are a few great snowmobile routes to ride in Vilas County this year.

Route #1: Land O' Lakes, Phelps & Conover

Enjoy a ride in far northern Vilas County along the Wisconsin/Upper Michigan border to find wonderfully scenic sites around North and South Twin Lake, the sprawling Lac Vieux Desert and the wooded wilderness of the Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest. Or head north into Michigan's Upper Peninsula to continue your snowmobiling adventure in a snow-covered wilderness.

Route #2: St. Germain and Eagle River

Eagle River is the Snowmobile Capital of the World®—come see why. Launch your snowmobiling adventure in Eagle River and zoom across the frozen waters of Eagle River's famous chain of lakes or head north toward Conover to enjoy the quieter Mathwig Creek Trail. Eagle River is also home to the World Championship Snowmobile Derby, which takes place every January.

You can find the Snowmobile Hall of Fame and Museum in St. Germain, so they know what they're talking about when it comes to riding. More than 100 miles of trails surround the community, passing scenic vistas along the shores of Little and Big St. Germain Lake.

Route #3: Lac du Flambeau, Manitowish Waters, Winchester & Presque Isle

Get away from the crowds on these trails that traverse snowmobile-friendly communities throughout western Vilas County. Enjoy a ride through several wonderful sections of the Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest.

Route #4: Boulder Junction & Sayner-Star Lake

Launch your snowmobile adventure in Boulder Junction, and you'll find more than 100 miles of well-maintained trails that connect to routes in nearby communities like Sayner-Star Lake and Manitowish Waters. Boulder Junction's trails take riders through wonderful Northwoods scenery and along the shores of dozens of lakes.

Sayner-Star Lake is the birthplace of the snowmobile (Carl Eliason invented the "motor toboggan" here in 1924) and today offers more than 75 miles of trails, including Trail 51, which runs through the heart of the Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest and is one of the oldest trails in the state.



Stay safe on your Vilas County snowmobile trip

Visitors from across the state, the Midwest, and the country come to Vilas County every winter to explore our outstanding system of snowmobile trails. Riders can explore hundreds of miles of trails groomed and maintained by dedicated local snowmobile clubs, and Vilas County is a great hub for launching a snowmobiling excursion into other counties in Wisconsin's Northwoods or the Upper Peninsula of Michigan.

But it's important to follow the rules to stay safe and make your snowmobile vacation one you'll remember for a lifetime. Here are a few reminders from the Vilas County Public Health Department and the Forestry, Recreation & Land Department:



- Any rider born after **January 1, 1985**, is required to complete a snowmobile safety course and carry a safety certificate.
- Children under the age of 12 may not operate a snowmobile unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Wear a helmet and appropriate clothing.
- Maintain a safe speed and follow all regulatory trail signs.
- Going off marked trails is trespassing.
- Look for the brown Trail Information Numbering signs at intersections.
- Use caution when crossing marked lake trails.
- Never ride alone.
- Know the snowmobile you are riding.
- Alcohol and snowmobiling don't mix.
- Always ride right.

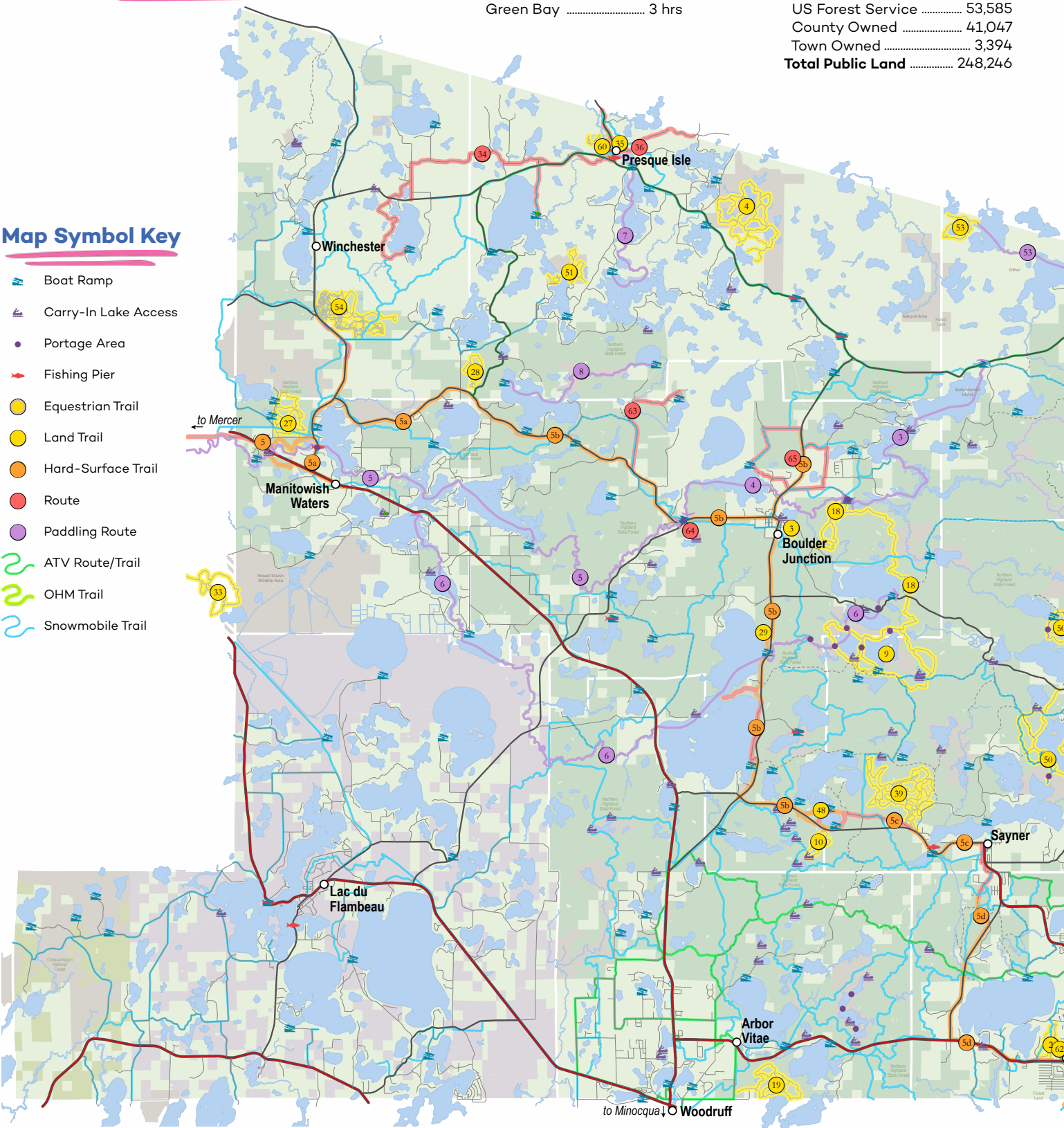

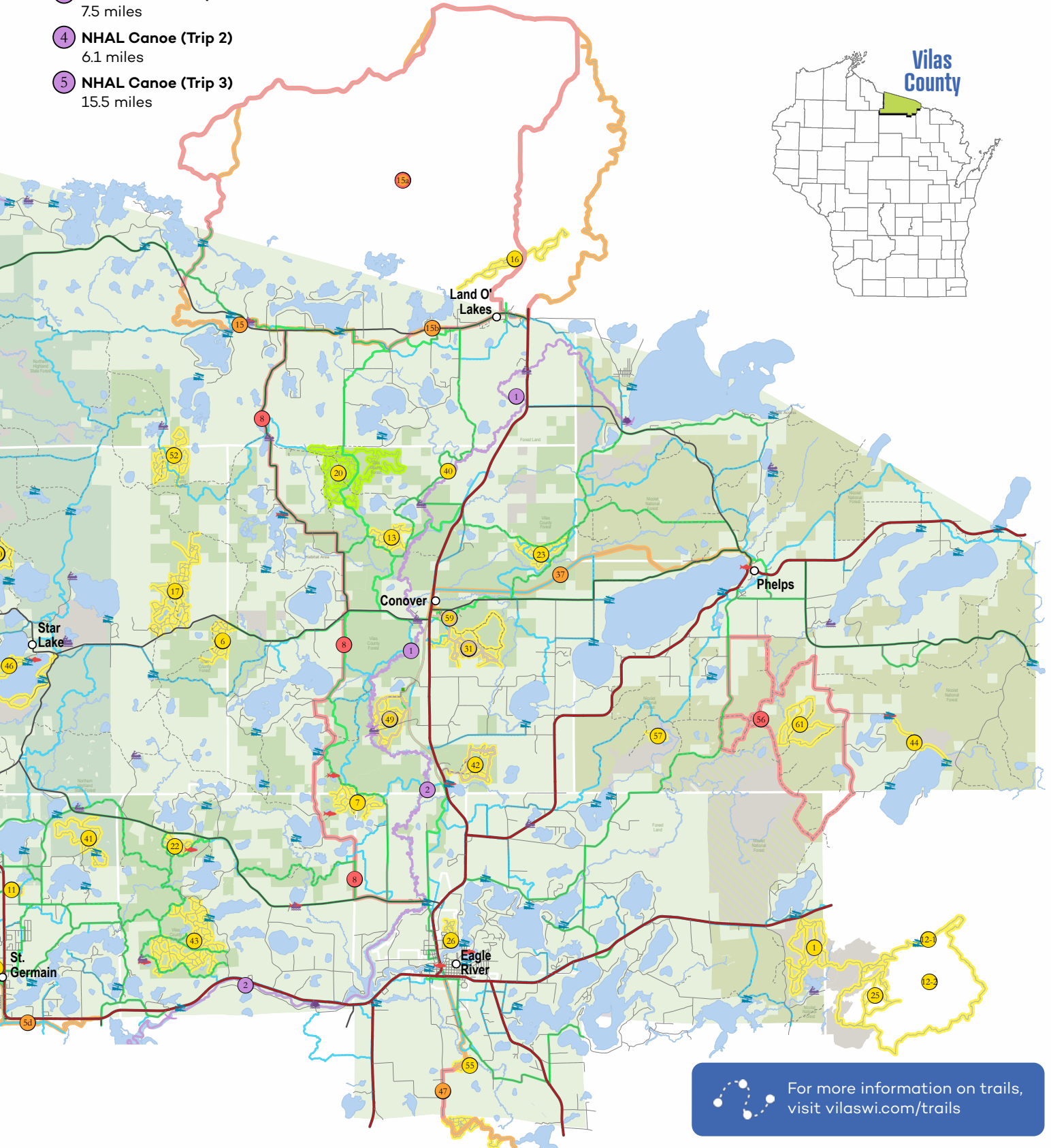

Make sure your next ride in Vilas County is a safe one—here are some helpful tips from the Vilas County Recreational Trail Safety Committee.

Biking

- Be predictable and visible.
- Use clear hand signals.
- Use lights at night.
- Be considerate.
- Always wear a helmet.



ATVing/UTVing

- Any rider born after **January 1, 1988**, is required to carry a safety certificate.
- Children aged 12-15 must have an ATV safety certificate and be accompanied by an adult while operating on an ATV/UTV route.
- All children under age 18 must wear an ATV/UTV or motorcycle helmet and goggles.
- No ATV operators under age 12 and no UTV operators under age 16 may operate on a public roadway.
- All UTV passengers must wear safety restraints.
- Off-trail riding is trespassing.
- ATVs/UTVs must have their headlamps on at all times.
- Alcohol and riding don't mix.
