### See Vilas County's Top Lakes

Vilas County is home to one of the largest concentrations of fresh water in the world—no matter where you go, you'll find fantastic lakes for fishing, paddling, and boating. Visit *vilas.org/lakes-rivers* to learn more about some of the Northwoods' top public-access lakes.



### Paddling Trips in the Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest

The Northern Highland-American Legion (NHAL) State Forest covers more than 236,000 acres in three counties in northern Wisconsin and is home to more than 900 lakes, so it's the perfect place for a paddling excursion. Those looking for a longer paddling trip can choose from several routes along the Manitowish River that include lake and river stretches and easy access to the NHAL's campgrounds.

#### High Lake to Fishtrap Dam:

This paddling route near Boulder Junction takes paddlers on High Lake and Fishtrap Lakes and past Johnson and Nixon creeks

Trip distance: 8 miles
Paddle time: 4 hours

#### Fishtrap Dam to Highway K:

Another route near Boulder Junction, this shorter trip runs from Fishtrap Dam through Boulder Lake to Highway K

Trip distance: 2.8 miles

(Fishtrap Dam to Highway M); 3.6 miles

(Highway M to Highway K)

Paddle time: 3 hours

#### Highway K to Highway 51:

A longer trip that would likely include an overnight stay, this route passes through several lakes in the Manitowish chain; for a shorter trip, take out at the Island Lake boat landing

Trip distance: 8.2 miles

(Highway K to Island Lake Landing); 7.5 miles (Island Lake to Highway W); 1.5 miles (Highway W to Highway 51)

Paddle time: 12 hours

#### White Sand Lake to Manitowish

**Lake:** One of the longest of the DNR's recommended NHAL paddling routes, this trip includes several portages; a side trip on the Lost Canoe Lake portage offers beautiful paddling on Escanaba and Pallette lakes

Trip distance: 22.8 miles
Paddle time: 12 hours

### **Keep Vilas County's Lakes** & Rivers Clean

Help keep invasive aquatic species out of waters in Vilas County and across the state. Wisconsin has several laws in place for boaters and anglers to help prevent the introduction and spread of invasive species.

#### All boaters are required to:

- Inspect their boat, trailers, and equipment before and after boating
- Remove all attached aquatic plants and animals before launchina. after loading, and before transporting watercraft on a public highway
- Drain all water from boats, motors, and equipment after boating
- Never move plants or live fish away from a body of water
- Dispose of unwanted bait in the trash
- Buy minnows from a Wisconsin bait dealer: leftover minnows can only be used in certain instances

Violations of these laws can lead to fines. Learn more about boat transportation and bait laws at dnr.wisconsin. gov/topic/invasives/boat.

### Explore the Northwoods' Abundant Lake Chains

Want to see a lot of lakes in a little time? Explore one of Vilas County's vast chains of lakes. Here are five you shouldn't miss.

#### Cisco Chain

Located in far northern Vilas
County, the Cisco Chain spans
the Wisconsin-Upper Michigan
border and takes boaters into
several scenic lakes in Gogebic
County. Big Lake, West Bay Lake,
and Mamie Lake extend from Vilas
County north into the U.P. and
connect with lakes like Lindsley
Lake, Thousand Island Lake, and
Cisco Lake.

#### **Eagle River Chain**

This lake chain in southeastern Vilas County is a popular spot for fishing, boating, and paddling, and it is the largest freshwater chain of lakes in the world. All told, the nearly 30 lakes in the chain offer 174 miles of shoreline. The Eagle River portion of the chain includes nine lakes covering 3,600 acres, including Catfish Lake, Cranberry Lake, and Long Lake.



#### Lac du Flambeau Chain

This spring-fed chain in southwestern Vilas County is known for its good fishing and clear water. It's anchored by Fence Lake (3,483 acres), which is home to musky, panfish, smallmouth bass, northern pike, and walleye. Two of the chain's lakes—Long Interlaken and Pokegama Lake—border downtown Lac du Flambeau.

#### Manitowish Chain O' Lakes

In Manitowish Waters, this chain of lakes includes some interesting Northwoods history—at Little Bohemia Lodge on Little Star Lake, you can still see evidence (including bullet holes!) of a 1934 shootout between gangster John Dillinger and the FBI. Other lakes on the chain include Rest Lake, Stone Lake, Fawn Lake, Clear Lake, Island Lake, Alder Lake, Spider Lake, Wild Rice Lake, and Manitowish Lake.

#### Minocqua Chain

Just south of Arbor Vitae in the Minocqua Area, this chain consists of nearly 6,000 acres of water and contains some massive lakes, including Tomahawk Lake (3,462 acres) and Lake Minocqua (1,339 acres).

# See how Two Great Lake Chains are Connected

Boaters traveling between the Eagle River chain and the Three Lakes chain near Eagle River can take advantage of a unique piece of technology that's helped connect the two waterways since the early 1900s.

#### The Burnt Rollways Dam and Boat Hoist,

located on the Eagle River as it flows into Cranberry Lake south of Highway 70, lifts boats up into the Three Lakes chain (where the water is higher) or lowers them into the Eagle River chain. Boaters pay a \$10 one-way fee or \$15 round-trip fee to use the hoist, which is open daily from May through the last Sunday of September.

The boat hoist can haul watercraft weighing up to 7,500 pounds and is even used for jet skis (canoes and kayaks are not hoisted, however).

The first boat hoist was built in 1911 by the Wisconsin Valley Improvement Company, and the name "burnt rollways" may have come from a lumberjack dispute. Apparently a group of lumberjacks was upset that the man who hired them couldn't pay, so they put his timber on a rollway (a device that rolled logs into the creek to be floated to a sawmill), set the rollway on fire, and pushed it into nearby Ninemile Creek.

# Fishing

### Find the Best Fishing in the Northwoods

Cast your line into an angler's paradise in Vilas County. We're home to more than 1,300 lakes—one of the largest concentrations of fresh water found anywhere on earth—and are famous for our world—class fishing for smallmouth bass, walleye, and musky. Whether you're tracking down a trophy fish with one of our expert and experienced guides or just casting from the dock at a local resort, you're sure to find great fishing wherever you go in Vilas County.



### What Kinds of Fish You'll Catch in Vilas County

Here's a closer look at the fish you can find in Vilas County and some suggestions on where to cast a line.



#### Musky

Wisconsin's state fish, these giants can top 4 feet in length and are known as ferocious fighters.

Where to find them: Boulder Junction is known as the Musky Capital of the World® for good reason—there are more than 50 Class-A musky lakes in and around the town



**Northern pike** Another fun fighter, northern pike can be distinguished from musky via their horizontal markings, scales on the lower part of their gill covers, and rounded tail fins.

Where to find them: Little St. Germain Lake, St. Germain; Silver Lake, Eagle River



#### Walleye

One of the most popular game fish in Wisconsin, walleye can be found in hundreds of Northwoods lakes.

Where to find them: Alder Lake, Manitowish Waters; Long Lake, Phelps



#### **Smallmouth bass**

This hard-fighting fish can generally be found in rocky lakes where its favorite food (crayfish) is present.

Where to find them: Big Lake, Presque Isle; Big Arbor Vitae Lake, Minocqua



#### Largemouth bass

The largest member of the sunfish family, largemouth bass are known as "bucketmouth" and like to hang out in warm water and under cover like lily pads, docks, or weed beds.

Where to find them: Ballard Lake, Sayner-Star Lake; Lake Helen, Winchester



#### Panfish

This class of fish—which includes bluegill, crappie, sunfish, perch, bluegill, and more—are fun to catch on light tackle and can be found in most Vilas County lakes.

Where to find them: Black Oak

Lake, Land O' Lakes; Gunlock Lake, Lac du Flambeau



#### Lake trout

These fish naturally reproduce in some northern Wisconsin lakes and are stocked in some of the state's deepest lakes. Brook trout and other species can also be found in some Vilas County rivers and streams.

Where to find them: Trout Lake, Boulder Junction; Upper Buckatabon Lake, Conover

#### Join the Fun on Free Fishing Weekends

Cast a line in Vilas County lakes without a license on the Wisconsin DNR's Free Fishing Weekends, held the third full weekend in January (January 18-19, 2025) and the first full weekend in June (June 7-8, 2025).

# 4 Seasons of Fishing in the Northwoods

You'll find fantastic fishing no matter what time of year you visit Vilas County. Here's what to expect when you're fishing in each of the Northwoods' different seasons.

#### Winter

Vilas County is a great ice fishing destination, with more than 1,300 lakes that are home to northern pike, walleye, panfish, and more—you'll see lots of shanties, tents, and other setups on the ice as you travel through the Northwoods. In general in the winter, northerns can be found on weed edges and in deeper weeds (set your tip ups so your bait is just above the weeds), walleye hang out on the edge of deep water, and panfish can be lured with small jigs.

#### **Spring**

Wisconsin's general inland fishing season opens on the first Saturday in May, and the musky season in the state's northern zone—which includes Vilas County—opens on the Saturday before Memorial Day.

Crappie, bluegill, and perch are more active in spring. Spring is a popular time for musky fishing, but use smaller baits earlier in the year—musky are looking for bigger baits later in the year when they're preparing for winter.

#### **Summer**

In mid-summer, fishing is best early in the morning or in the afternoon or on overcast days. Largemouth and smallmouth bass are well into their spawning season in May and June, so early summer is a good time for fish for these hard fighters. Now is when you should start using bigger baits for musky.

#### Fall

Fall is one of the best times to go fishing in the Northwoods, as fish go on a feeding frenzy and there are fewer anglers on the water, so you'll find less competition for northern pike, walleye, and musky. Fall is a particularly good time to go after Vilas County's massive musky, as they're looking to feed and bulk up before winter

# Find outdoor recreation options you'll love

No matter what you love to do outside, you'll find a great place for it in Vilas County. Hikers and bikers will find nearly 100 multi-use trails that pass through stunning Northwoods scenery. Canoers and kayakers can explore picture-perfect lakes where your only company may be the call of a loon. Winter sports enthusiasts can tromp or ski through freshly fallen snow, or those looking for faster pursuits can ride more than 500 miles of some of the Midwest's best snowmobile trails.

Plan your next outdoor adventure in Vilas County today.

### Lakeshore Hikes in Vilas County

With more than 1,300 lakes dotting the landscape in Vilas County, it's easy for nature lovers to find a scenic trail to traverse—include a few that follow the shores of some beautiful Northwoods lakes.

#### Star Lake Nature Trail. Star Lake

This short but beautiful trail sits on a peninsula that juts out into Star Lake. The trail crosses picturesque stretches of boardwalk, but some of the most scenic views are at the water's edge.

#### Spectacle Lake-Kentuck Lake Trail, Phelps


This scenic trail travels through a colorful deciduous forest between two campgrounds. In the warmer months, hikers and campers can enjoy the swimming beach at Spectacle Lake. It's worth a visit in any season, though.

#### Shannon Lake Trail, St. Germain

This trail system takes hikers through a variety of beautiful stands of northern hardwoods, but one of the most scenic stretches is a loop around Shannon Lake.

#### Catherine Wolter Wilderness Area, Presque Isle

This pristine wilderness area is laced with trails that go past undeveloped waters like Knife Lake, Canteen Lake, and John Lake.



### Bike the Heart of Vilas County Trail

Vilas County is home to one of the state's best bike trails—the Heart of Vilas County Paved Bike Trail System spans more than 50 miles through the communities of St. Germain, Sayner-Star Lake-Cloverland, Boulder Junction, and Manitowish Waters in Vilas County before ending in Mercer in neighboring Iron County.

The paved trail, which has been recognized as a National Recreational Trail, is suitable for all riders and a trail pass is not required.

Here's a closer look at the different sections of the trail in Vilas County:

**St. Germain:** Find the main trailhead behind the St. Germain Chamber of Commerce, where Highway 70 meets Highway 155. This trail connects with Sayner and passes a wayside with restrooms, a picnic area and the Awassa Nature Preserve & Hiking Trail, for those in the mood for a shady, level walk.

#### Sayner-Star Lake-Cloverland:

Park at Froelich Drive and County Highway N to access this trail. It runs from County Highways M & N east toward Sayner, passing the Crystal Lake Campground, beautiful lakes, and picnic areas perfect for a quick lunch or snack stop.

Boulder Junction: Hop on this trail by the Boulder Junction Chamber of Commerce building and bike south to Crystal Lake or bike west towards Manitowish Waters. You'll find plenty of scenic stops perfect for taking beautiful photos along the way, as well as a picnic area.

Manitowish Waters: You can access this trail from several points, including the Manitowish Waters Community Center, Koller Park, Rest Lake Park, and the North Lakeland Discovery Center. There are restrooms and water stops along the way, plus a playground.





# One Bike Trail to Ride in Each Vilas County Community

As bikers travel through Vilas County's welcoming communities, they'll find dozens of routes to explore, from short, scenic loops to challenging single-track terrain. Here are a few rides that shouldn't be missed.

### Boulder Junction LUMBERJACK TRAIL

This scenic trail system in the Northern Highland-American Legion (NHAL) State Forest winds along several scenic waterways, including White Sand Lake, the Fishtrap Flowage, and the Manitowish River. Trail segments range from 1.5 miles to nearly 6 miles, and the Lumberjack Trail connects to the Escanaba-Pallette Lake Trail to the south.

### Conover & Phelps CONOVER-PHELPS TRAIL

This flat, level trail connects
Conover and Phelps via a 10-mile
aggregate and asphalt route that
follows the former route of the
Chicago Northwestern railroad. The
trail passes through woodlands
and wetlands and offers nice views
along three water crossings.

### Eagle River ANVIL LAKE TRAIL

Located in the Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest, the Anvil Lake Trails—part of the National Recreational Trail System—offer riding for all levels of mountain bikers, from beginners to experts. The site's seven trails pass through the scenic national forest and connect to the Nicolet North Trail System to the east.

# Land O' Lakes EAGLE RIVER-LAND O' LAKES BIKE ROUTE

This 22-mile route connects Land O' Lakes in northern Vilas County to Eagle River in the southern part of the county. The route follows quiet forest roads and passes several calm Northwoods lakes along a generally level path that has some gentle hills.

### Manitowish Waters & Winchester WINMAN TRAILS

It's easy to see why the WinMan Trails, located halfway between Manitowish Waters and Winchester in northwestern Vilas County, are a popular destination for mountain bikers. The trails sit on 1,300 acres of public and private land and offer rides for all abilities, from beginners to experts. WinMan boasts more than 23 miles of flow, cross-country, and downhill single-track trails.

### Minocqua Area RAVEN TRAIL

Another NHAL State Forest trail system, the Raven Trail near Clear Lake east of Minocqua offers nearly 15 miles of trails. Most of the system is for intermediate riders, but there is also a 4.5-mile expert loop. There is also a bike skills course on the trail system that includes log rides, bridges, teeter totters, and rocky areas. A state trail pass is required for biking where noted.

### Phelps VISTA LAKE BIKE ROUTES

Ride through the Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest—a sprawling natural area that covers 11 counties in northern Wisconsin—on these three trails near Phelps. The trails range from 2.9 miles (a loop around Vista Lake) to 13.1 miles (a longer ride that passes Imogene Lake, Dewey Lake, and the Bearskin River). The trail surface is mostly gravel but some include sections of pavement or hard-packed loam.

### Presque Isle PIPKE PARK TRAIL SYSTEM

This short but scenic trail takes riders on a trip through beautiful scenery and a little Northwoods history. The Pond Trail (approximately 1.5 miles) loops around a set of "hot ponds"—heated mill ponds that didn't freeze, allowing lumber companies to store logs all winter long—and consists of an aggregate surface.

### Sayner-Star Lake-Cloverland RAZORBACK RIDGES

This beautiful trail system 2 miles west of Sayner offers riders more than 16 miles of mountain biking trails that pass through some gorgeous Vilas County scenery. (Note that the trails are also open to hikers.) The trail system—also a popular cross-country skiing and snowshoeing destination in winter—is a community project between the Sayner-Star Lake Lions Club and the Wisconsin DNR.

#### St. Germain

#### **HEART OF VILAS COUNTY TRAIL**

The Heart of Vilas County Trail is actually a great way to see several communities throughout the county—the paved route spans more than 50 miles and passes through St. Germain as well as Sayner-Star Lake-Cloverland, Boulder Junction, and Manitowish Waters before ending in Mercer in neighboring Iron County.

# Stay safe on your Vilas County snowmobile trip

VIsitors from across the state, the Midwest, and the country come to Vilas County every winter to explore our outstanding system of snowmobile trails. Riders can explore hundreds of miles of trails groomed and maintained by dedicated local snowmobile clubs, and Vilas County is a great hub for launching a snowmobiling excursion into other counties in Wisconsin's Northwoods or the Upper Peninsula of Michigan.

But it's important to follow the rules to stay safe and make your snowmobile vacation one you'll remember for a lifetime. Be sure to follow these safety tips from the Vilas County Public Health Deparment and the Forest, Recreation & Land Department.



- Any rider born after January 1,
   1985, is required to complete a
   snowmobile safety course and carry
   a safety certificate.
- Children under the age of 12 may not operate a snowmobile unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Wear a helmet and appropriate clothing.
- Maintain a safe speed and follow all regulatory trail signs.
- Going off marked trails is trespassing.
- Look for the brown Trail Information Numbering signs at intersections.
- Use caution when crossing marked lake trails.
- Never ride alone.
- Know the snowmobile you are riding.
- Alcohol and snowmobiling don't mix.
- Always ride right.





### Ride safely in Vilas County

Vilas County is home to dozens of trails to explore, from paved bike paths that follow the shores of shimmering lakes to backwoods ATV and UTV routes that cut through towering Northwoods pines.

Make sure your next ride in Vilas County is a safe one—here are some helpful tips from the Vilas County Public Health Department and the Recreational Trail Safety Committee.

### **Biking**

- Be predictable and visible.
- Use clear hand signals.
- Use lights at night.
- Be considerate.
- Always wear a helmet.



### **ATVing/UTVing**

- Any rider born after January 1,
   1988, is required to carry a safety certificate.
- Children aged 12-15 must have an ATV safety certificate and be accompanied by an adult while operating on an ATV/UTV route.
- All children under age 18 must wear an ATV/UTV or motorcycle helmet and goggles.
- No ATV operators under age 12 and no UTV operators under age 16 may operate on a public roadway.
- All UTV passengers must wear safety restraints.
- Off-trail riding is trespassing.
- ATVs/UTVs must have their headlamps on at all times.
- Alcohol and riding don't mix.

### What to Know About Snowmobiling in Vilas County

Wondering why Vilas County is such a great snowmobiling destination? Here are just a few reasons:

- Vilas County is home to 500 miles of snowmobile trails, which are overseen and groomed by 11 snowmobile clubs
- Vilas County's trails also connect with hundreds more miles of trails throughout Wisconsin's Northwoods and Michigan's Upper Peninsula
- Sayner-Star Lake-Cloverland in central Vilas County is known as "the birthplace of the snowmobile" because Carl Eliason created a "motor toboggan" the precursor of the modern snowmobile—in a garage behind his general store here in 1924
- Snowmobile fans can find two fun snowmobile attractions in Vilas County: the World Snowmobile Headquarters in Eagle River and the Snowmobile Hall of Fame in St. Germain
- Snowmobile clubs and other local organizations host fun events throughout the snowmobiling season in northern Wisconsin, including the annual World Championship Snowmobile Derby in Eagle River


### All about ATVing & VTVing

- Vilas County's ATV/UTV route system connects the communities of St. Germain, Arbor Vitae, Lincoln, Eagle River, Conover, Phelps, Presque Isle, and Land O' Lakes
- Download the **Map It Vilas County trails app** to help you navigate the area's local ATV/UTV club trails
- Vilas County's ATV/UTV routes are open from early May through the end of October, depending on trail conditions
- ATV and UTV users born on or after January 1, 1988, who are at least 12 years old (the age requirement is 16 for UTVers) must complete a safety certification course in order to operate on public ATV/UTV trails in Wisconsin

### Explore Vilas County's Rustic Road

Looking for a scenic drive during fall color season? Then take a ride on Vilas County's only Rustic Road. Rustic Road 60 is a 12-mile route that connects Boulder Junction with Star Lake and passes by several lakes, including White Sand Lake, Lost Canoe Lake, White Birch Lake, Ballard Lake, and Little Star Lake. Enjoy the view as you pass under canopies of coniferous and hardwood trees along the route.





If you're lucky, you might be in Vilas County at the right time for one of Mother Nature's most extraordinary shows: the Northern Lights. Here's what you need to know about how, when, and where to best see the aurora borealis.

### Where can I see the Northern Lights in Vilas County?

The Northern Lights are visible anywhere there's an unobstructed view of the sky—parks, campsites, and lakeside resorts are all good spots to see the show in the Northwoods.

If you're staying at one of Vilas County's lakeside resorts, pick a spot on the south side of the lake as you'll likely be looking toward the northern horizon to see the aurora.

#### When can I see the Northern Lights?

The most common times to see the northern lights are in spring and winter (and sometimes fall), as nights are longer.

It's hard to predict the Northern Lights, so you can sign up for an email alert service like Aurora Watch or check websites that update conditions regularly.

#### Tips for seeing the Northern Lights

- Pick a clear night with no threat of snow or rain
- Stay away from areas with light pollution (e.g., cities)
- Look for an unobstructed view to the north—the Northern Lights are rarely directly overhead in Wisconsin
- If there are trees near your viewing spot, the treeline should ideally be lower than a fist's height held at arm's length
- Be patient—auroras may last from 15 minutes up to several hours

And even if you don't catch Northern Lights, Vilas County is a great spot for stargazers—you'll see lots of constellations (and maybe even the Milky Way!) on a clear night in the Northwoods.
